## PLATFORM TENNIS RULES & GUIDELINES

1. **In order to play on the courts and reserve court time, you must be a registered player.** Although the courts are under combination lock accessible to permit holders only, all players are still required to prove their identity when requested to do so by a member of the Recreation Department staff. If you have not yet registered, you will be required to pay the \$10.00 one-time use fee. This fee will not be applied to the cost of your seasonal registration.
2. **RESERVATION SYSTEM - 941-6129**  
**ADVANCE PHONE RESERVATIONS: WEEKENDS ONLY!! Beginning Friday, November 6<sup>th</sup>**  
To reserve court time for weekend play, registered players may call the Recreation Office on Fridays **between 9:30 am and 11:00 am.**
  - RESERVATIONS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED ON THE 941-6129 PHONE LINE.
  - ONLY ONE RESERVATION PER CALL WILL BE ACCEPTED.**ADVANCE ON-SITE RESERVATIONS:**  
The sign-up sheets will be posted at the courts on Friday afternoons by approximately 1:00 pm. Those registrants who did not phone in to reserve court time may reserve one of the remaining time slots.
3. Guests are permitted to use the courts only when they are accompanied by a registered player. The guest fee is \$10.00 per guest per session and must be prepaid at the Recreation Office. Registered players are responsible for the actions of their guests.
4. If the persons who have reserved a court have not shown up by 10 minutes after the hour, the remainder of the time slot can be used by anyone who is a registered player.
5. Players are urged to go to the courts and remove their names if for some reason they will be unable to play according to their reservations.
6. All players are requested not to use the courts during or after a snow storm until the courts have been properly cleaned. Failure to observe this request causes ice and dangerous playing conditions for those who follow.
7. The use of Village owned and operated facilities for private instruction is not permitted.
8. Please keep the courts and surrounding areas neat and clean.
9. All Platform Tennis players are reminded to conduct themselves in a manner that will show consideration for those who may be playing, or live nearby.
10. The Recreation Department reserves the right to preempt any court time in order to conduct department sanctioned matches, instruction, tournaments and other special activities.
11. The cooperation of all players is needed to provide a fair and equitable program. Players are on the **HONOR SYSTEM** when it comes to abiding by these rules. However, the Recreation Department will make periodic checks to be sure the rules are being adhered to.
