BALLOT ISSUE: NOVEMBER 8, 2005 GENERAL ELECTION

The Mayor and the Board of Trustees have directed that the following ballot issue be placed on the general election ballot on November 8:

To increase the Village contribution to the investment program for Fire Department volunteers which is known as the Defined Contribution Service Award Program. This program was created in 1993, and this is the first time that the State has given municipalities the opportunity to increase the benefits provided from the program. The ballot will also allow fire department volunteers to earn points after age 65. Points are earned based on service to the department and the number of volunteers who qualify annually determines the Village contribution to the investment benefit. The maximum annual payment to these volunteers increase as shown below.

The Chart below outlines the proposed changes:

VILLAGE MANAGER'S UPDATE

The Village received a grant of \$6,500 from the Hudson River Greenway Conservancy to study the creation of a trail way system in Village-owned undeveloped parklands. The feasibility of connecting these lands to existing parks will be studied. After a consultant is selected, the study should commence in October.

The renovation of Chilmark Park will be the focus of a consultant who specializes in parks and recreational facilities. The possibility of creating a full-court basketball facility from the existing half-court, to be considered as part of the plan that is slated to begin in October.

Three important Village construction projects are scheduled: Todd Lane bridge replacement; Replacement of sanitary sewer pump stations on Cottonwood Lane and Holly Place; Cement lining of water lines (primarily on Route 9)

MEET THE VILLAGE STAFF: Norman Campion, Police Chief

Norman Campion has served as the Chief of Police since March of 2004, but has been with the Briarcliff Manor Police Department since 1988 when he joined as a police officer. In 1990 Chief Campion became the first D.A.R.E. Officer in Briarcliff Manor and in 1997, he was promoted to Sergeant. Prior to joining the Briarcliff Manor Police Department, Chief Campion served with the City of Mount Vernon Police Department for three years as a police officer assigned to the patrol division.



Chief Campion holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice and has attended many in-service training programs during his career. He grew up in Yonkers, New York and is a life-long County resident. He now lives in northern Westchester with his wife and two children.

Chief Campion looks forward to the challenge of moving the Police Department into a more technology-based operation. He points out that police work is rapidly changing and advancing, thus he hopes to modernize the Police Department through the use of computers and up-to-date technologies in order to bring better police service to the Village.
