THE MANAGER'S REPORT

Con Edison has commenced a new Tree Maintenance Program that is considerably more aggressive than past tree trimming efforts by the company. Con Edison experienced considerable outages throughout the County, which according to company representatives, were caused primarily by trees (branches falling off trees, branches rubbing on electric lines). The goal of the current Tree Maintenance Program, per Con Edison, is to maintain uninterrupted electrical service, prevent fires, eliminate the risk of electrocution and generally, protect the public safety.

The new Tree Maintenance Program includes trimming back of branches from the electric line to a greater distance than before, the removal of trees that may impact upon the electric lines in the future, and a decision by the company that any tree that is designated for removal will be removed, regardless of the desire of the property owner or the Village that the tree not be removed.

Con Edison has informed the Village that pursuant to the Public Service Law and the National Electric Safety Code, they are required and legally bound to maintain their systems. The first loop to be completed in Briarcliff Manor by Con Edison is along the following streets and is scheduled to begin in April, 2007:



The Village asks that you do the following when paying your water bill:


- include your payment coupon with your check;
