THE MANAGER'S REPORT

The audio portion of the Board of Trustees meetings has been problematic for some time. The Board expressed concern and staff attempted to address the problem internally. The problem has persisted and the improvement in the audio has been minimal. The Village has hired a professional firm in the field of audio-video production and the firm will be making recommendations to the Village as to how to solve the problem. Village staff will be reviewing the recommendation and issuing a report to the Board, which includes an analysis of the financial impact of the recommendation. The Village is moving as quickly as possible, now that the professional firm has been hired to correct the audio problem.

The cable casting of the Board of Trustees meetings, as well as the Planning Board and Zoning Board of Appeals is an operational responsibility and rests ultimately with the Village Manager. I would like to assure all residents that the Village staff has been working on this problem for months, has been unable to correct the problem in-house, and has now sought professional services to correct the problem.
